Director Report

Since the donation of our van and trailer in summer, we were excited to put it to use by running day camps in the First Nations communities.

A Christian school in Winnipeg reached out to us in summer and asked if we could facilitate a ministry trip for a group of their high school students as a part of their ministry program. We saw the Lord's hand in putting all the pieces together to make this a possibility. On March 24th we left for Moose Lake MB. with 13 students and two chaperones. We were joined by Timothy and Laura Block and most of their kids.

The day camp ran from Monday to Thursday and we had an average of 30 kids each day. The students had clearly put in a lot of work to prepare the program for this day camp. They served with joy and enthusiasm and represented Steeprock in a very positive way. The community made it very clear that they were grateful to have us come. They generously offered the school and provided rides for the kids to and from the school each day.

We are grateful for the relationship we have built with one couple in particular. They have lived in Moose Lake all their lives and are believers. They have been registering kids for summer camp for a number of years and have a desire to see kids come to know Jesus. We pray for them often and seek to encourage them every time we visit. They came and shared their testimonies with our group one evening and we were all impacted by the way the Lord has worked in their lives.

Often we see people living in the midst of situations that seem hopeless and dead. It reminds me of the way God compared Israel to a valley of dry bones in Ezekiel. **Continued....**
