Since moving our teen camp to the beginning of the summer, we have been able to promote the Waymaker program much better and encourage teens to stay at camp for more than one week so they can be taught the word, be shown how to serve, and be trained in leadership skills. He stood out to me because of his impressive knowledge of the Bible and the great questions he asked. The boy informed me that he had sent a note along with his brother and it was for me. I walked across the yard and sure enough another boy came up to me and said "Here, my brother sent this note for you." In the note he thanked us for the time he had at camp two years ago and he shared his regret that he wasn't able to come this summer. Then he shared about his struggle with addiction and thanked us for helping him. He ended with "I'm clean for two years now I'm doing better. Thank you and yes I still follow God."

Moments like these remind me of the work God is doing whether we know it or not. It reminds me to keep pressing on even if our interactions seem insignificant. When we are faithful in what God has called us to, He does the work.
