We're excited as we gear up for another summer of ministry at Steeprock Bay Bible Camp. This will be our second year following a new schedule for the year: I worked on the farm until the end of February, and now I'm taking six months off for ministry, family, and catching up on things around home.

Life looks a little different for our family this year as we've welcomed another little boy—Maverick—who is already nearing five months old! With this change, Alicia will be primarily focused on caring for our boys. We're praying the Lord will provide someone to help with the camp grocery shopping so she doesn't have to carry that responsibility this year.

For the past two years, we've taken a group of high school students from Faith Academy in Winnipeg to run a day camp in the community of Moose Lake during spring break. Once again we were very impressed with the group and their enthusiasm for serving the Lord. Each day we had about 30 children attend the day camp. They really enjoyed the time we spent with them. During our past visits, Alicia and I have grown close to a couple who live in Moose Lake. They were saved in the early 90s and have been serving the Lord ever since—often feeling quite alone in their faith. Every year they register kids for Steeprock and arrange transportation so they can hear about Jesus. They've also opened their home to many foster children over the years. Currently, they're caring for three foster boys. During our visit, the oldest turned 12. His foster mom was in The Pas that day so she brought back pizza, wings, and an ice cream cake. She shared her testimony with our group, and we prayed for her before enjoying a meal together.
