Director Report

One of my long-standing dreams has been to see consistent off-season ministry taking place in the communities that send children to camp at SBBC. This spring, that dream felt especially tangible as we returned from a week of outreach in Moose Lake, The Pas, and Cormorant.

For the third year in a row, a group of grade 10–12 students from Faith Academy in Winnipeg led a day camp in the community. Timothy and Laura Block facilitated the group, and they did an excellent job serving both the students and the community during their stay. This community has welcomed SBBC over the years, and it is encouraging to watch trust and openness grow as we return year after year.

Tuesday afternoon I met up with 5 of our summer staff at Peter and Charlene's. We were also joined by 3 of our Leaders In Training from last summer which was a nice surprise. I was especially encouraged to realize that six of the staff who joined were once campers themselves and are now serving as staff.

Watching this transition from camper to leader is a powerful reminder of the fruit that comes from long-term ministry and discipleship.

On Tuesday, we spent time at the Big Eddy youth center where we shared songs, read the Easter story, and played games with the kids.

The following day, we visited a care home and held a small service for the residents. One woman shared that she had grown up learning God's Word from missionaries and had spent her life walking faithfully with the Lord and sharing her faith with others. Her testimony was very encouraging and a beautiful picture of enduring faith across generations.

Cormorant is a community where SBBC has had limited connection in the past, and we have been praying specifically for opportunities to build relationships and see more campers come from there. On Thursday, our team traveled to the school where we had arranged to use the gym for a couple of hours. When we eventually gained access, there was only one student there for the activities. I asked him if he knew any friends who might want to come, and he offered to show us where they lived. Before long, he and some of our staff hopped into the truck, and we returned with a truck box full of kids. We spent two hours playing games, sharing the Easter story and a testimony as well as singing songs, showing some camp highlight videos and encouraging them to come to camp. Two of the kids had attended SBBC before, and the rest were thrilled to hear about coming to camp this summer. As we reflected on the week, one theme stood out clearly: disciples making disciples. Out of the SBBC staff involved, most were once campers themselves. Seeing them now serving faithfully in off-season ministry brings tremendous joy and humility. Our prayer is that God will continue raising up believers in these communities who will, in turn, reach and disciple their own people. Thank you for walking alongside us—through prayer, encouragement, and support—as God continues His work through SBBC. Please continue to pray about how you might be involved in the season ahead.
